Sanitary and Storm Sewer Assessments

August 2020

Scope of Works

The Township of West Lincoln is undertaking a study of the sanitary and storm sewer systems in your area to determine the condition of both systems. The study will involve CCTV inspections, collection of GIS data of all sanitary/storm maintenance holes and outfalls, updating of asset data for Asset Management Planning, identification of sources of inflow & infiltration (I&I) and the development of a rehabilitation/replacement plan based on pipe condition and I&I source removal. The map below depicts the Study Area in which assessments will be taking place.




Figure 1: Study Area



When are the Works Occurring?

The storm and sewer assessments are scheduled to occur between August and December 2020. During this time, you may see work vehicles operating within the Study Area.

Who will be Conducting this Work?

The Township of West Lincoln is working with its Consultant Civica Infrastructure Inc. and their subcontractor Wessuc Inc. to carry out the assessment works. You may see vehicles with their logos (shown on right) conducting assessments in your area.



Will the Consultant Need to Enter My Home?

No, assessment works are being conducted on public infrastructure and will <u>not</u> require the consultant to enter your home. In certain cases, maintenance holes (MH) and sewer infrastructure may be located on private property and will require exterior property access only. If a public MH is located on your property, the consultant will notify you and coordinate entry. If you have questions regarding the validity of a request to access your property, the Township of West Lincoln will be happy to verify the validity.
